  - o Residential Information Systems Project (RISP)
  - State of the States in Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities

#### Year 1 Outcomes:

 Greater access to national data, including Illinois, for people to advocate and understand how Illinois is doing compared to other states/US as a whole

- A better understanding of case management practices across the US in 1915(c) waivers for people with IDD
